GAME DAY

UNIFORMS

These are to be worn for the game only – not to or from games.

Please do not use zinc cream on the children as this stains the uniforms.

We STRONGLY encourage you to use sunscreen.

These uniforms are provided by our sponsors so please support their businesses.

Children are not permitted to wear jewelry while playing or training. This rule excludes medic alert bracelets, which may be taped.

GAMES

A regulation teeball game shall be of nine innings or time limit allotted, whichever comes first. No even innings shall commence within five minutes of the scheduled finishing time. Once an innings has commenced it must be played to completion, which is both sides must bat.

Umpires & coaches are to ensure that all games start and finish on time.

Home teams are listed first in the fixture book and occupy the first base line, set up the diamond and field first. Home team must supply a plate umpire.

Away teams are listed second in the fixture book, occupy third base line and bat first. Away team must supply at least one base umpire.

BENCHES, SHADES & UMBRELLAS

Teams in the first timeslot are responsible for putting out the benches and sun shelters on their relevant diamonds.

Teams in the final timeslot please ensure that you put your benches and sun shelters away.

Player tents are for players ONLY. Parents, feel free to bring your own shade. There is not enough room for 2 teams, 2 coaches, 2 managers PLUS parents under one shade!

PLAYING RULES

A player must occupy a different position in each innings. No player can re-occupy that same position in that game unless there is an injury and a player must leave the field.

Players must not change fielding position in an innings unless injured.

A player must not sit out twice in a game unless all other players have sat out once.

In the first four innings a player must play at least once in an infield and at least once in an outfield position. Coaches are encouraged to place stronger players to back up and support weaker players, not to field the strongest team possible.

All players should be rotated and play equal time (or as close as possible to) in each of the nine fielding positions within the season.

FIRST AID

The association has a first aid box which will be situated on the table in the middle of the diamonds.

GROUND RULES

- *No player in the sub-junior competition may be run down by the pitcher whilst attempting to run to first base.*
- *An infield hit means a sub-junior player can run a MAXIMUM of 1 base. An outfield hit means a player can run a MAXIMUM of 2 bases.*
- *Balls hit over the fence ON THE FULL result in a home run*
- *Balls that hit the fence and bounce back into play will NOT stop play*
- *Balls hit UNDER the fence, or that bounce before going over the fence, shall award the batter 2 more bases from where the player was when the ball passed the fence line.*

CLUB MEETINGS

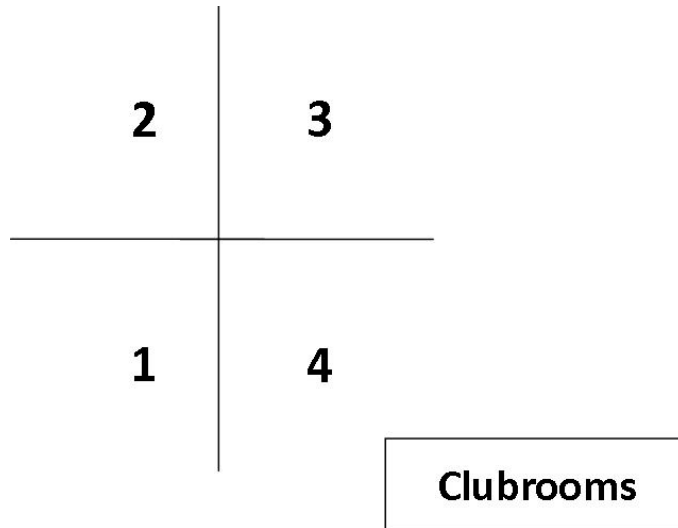
